This involves anticipating picking times from the information growers provide in our survey, available from early November.

The work is further scheduled based on the result of grape ripeness testing and winery preferences. Start and finish times are then scheduled and allowances for machinery delivery, hygiene requirements, on-site facilities and fuelling are all factored in. Timing is finally determined by weather conditions and the availability of machinery and staff.
